

# John Chapter 14 part 1

Em D G D F#  
Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.

Em G D Em  
In my Father's house are many abodes: if it were not so, I would have told you.

D G-----F# Em D G-----D Em  
I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you,

D G-----D Em A F-----G Em  
I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

Em-----G-----Bm-D Em--G-----Am F#  
And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know.

D Em D G D  
Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?

Em Am F G Am F Em G-----Am  
Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Em G Bm-D Em Am G F#  
If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also:

Em G Bm-D Em Am G F#  
and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.

Em D Em D G D  
Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us.

Em Am F G Am  
Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip?

F Em-----G Am F Em Am  
he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?

Em Am G D Em D  
Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me?

C D Em Bm Am D  
the words that I speak to you I speak not of myself:

Em D C D Em Am G F#  
but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.

C G Am Em C G Am  
Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.

C G Am Em C G Am  
Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also;

Em C D C D Em  
and greater works than these shall he do; because I go to my Father.

Em D C D  
And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

Em D C D Em C  
If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. If ye love me, keep my commandments.

G D Em D  
And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter,

C D EmAmGF#  
that he may abide with you for ever;

Em D C D Em Bm Am D Em  
Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not,

Em D C D Em D C D  
neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

Em Bm Am D Em  
I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.

# John Chapter 14 part 2

Em D C D  
Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more; but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also.  
Em C G D D Em Am G F#

At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.

Em D C D Em D  
He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me:

C D Em Bm Am D Em Am G F#  
and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself unto him.

Em D  
Judas saith unto him, not Iscariot,

Em D G D  
Lord, how is it that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world?

Em Am F  
Jesus answered and said to him, If a man love me, he will keep my words:

G Am F Em Am  
and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.

Em D  
He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings:

C D  
and the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me.

Em C G  
These things have I spoken unto you, being yet present with you.

D C D Em C D Em  
But the Comforter, which is the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name,  
C D Em C D Em C Em

he shall teach you all things, and cause you to remember all the things that I have said to you..  
Em C G D Em C D

Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you.  
Em C G D

Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.  
Em C G D

Ye have heard how I said to you, I go away, and come again  
Em C G D Em G D

If ye loved me, ye would rejoice, because I said, I go unto the Father: for my Father is greater than I.  
Em C G D Em C G

And now I have told you before it come to pass, that, when it is come to pass, ye might believe.  
Em D Em D Em D

Hereafter I will not talk much with you: for the prince of this world cometh, and hath nothing in me.  
C D Em C D

But that the world may know that I love the Father; and as the Father gave me commandment,  
Em Am G F# Em

Even so do I. Arise, let us go hence.
