

Joel Chapter 3 and 2:28-32 (part1)

Intro Em +9 +10

Em +10 D Em

And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh;

Em D C D Em D

and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions:

And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit.

And I will shew wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke.

will I return your recompense upon your own head;

Because ye have taken my silver and my gold, and have carried into your temples my goodly pleasant things:

The children of Judah and of Jerusalem have ye sold unto the Grecians, that ye might remove them far away.

Behold, I will raise them out of the place whither ye have sold them,

C D

and will return your recompense upon your own head:

And I will sell your sons and your daughters into the hand of the children of Judah,

and they shall sell them to the Sabeans, to a people far off: for the LORD has spoken it.

for the press is full, the fats overflow; for their wickedness is great.

Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision: for the day of the LORD is near in the valley of decision.

The sun and the moon shall be darkened, and the stars withdraw their shining.
Dm C Dm Am Am F Dm
The LORD also shall roar out of Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake:

but The LORD will be the hope of his people, and strength of the children of Israel.
Dm Am Dm C Dm Am
So shall ye know that I am The LORD your God dwelling in Zion, my holy mountain:
Dm C Dm Am Dm
then shall Jerusalem be holy, and there shall no strangers pass through her any more.
C Dm Am Dm
And it shall come to pass in that day, that the mountains shall drop down new wine,
C Dm Am Dm
and all the hills shall flow with milk, and all the rivers of Judah shall flow with waters,
C Dm C Dm Am
and a fountain shall come forth of the house of The LORD and water the valley of Shittim.

Egypt shall be a desolation, and Edom shall be a desolate wilderness,
Dm C Dm Am
for the violence against the children of Judah, because they have shed innocent blood in their land.
Dm Am Dm C Dm
But Judah shall dwell for ever, and Jerusalem from generation to generation.
Dm Am Dm C Dm Am Dm
For I will cleanse their blood I have not cleansed: for the LORD dwelleth in Zion.
